Growing Conditions

Our estate vineyard has been continuously owned and farmed by the Casorso / Sperling family since the 1880s, and we planted the slopes with vines starting in 1920s. For the 2020 growing season, we modified the pruning in our Old Vines Marechal Foch by moving all the fruiting canes to the top wire, therefore re-focusing the vine's energy.

> We fermented Marechal Foch whole clusters and berries for 5 days, then pressed, and blended in a bit of Pinot Noir. Fermentation finishes to complete dryness in bottle, trapping 1.5 atm. of bubbles. Naturaly occuring sediment remains in the bottle.
