Growing Conditions

2020 accumulated ~1340 GDD (Growing Degree Days) which seems to be the new normal for the 21st century. Even though the overall heat accumulation resembled 2018, the seasonal conditions were quite different. 2020 started out with very cool May & June, followed by a moderate July & then a very warm August & September. Grapes were sweeter & with more dark fruit characters.

Winemaking

Select panels were chosen & handharvested for our Vision series Pinot Noir. The grapes were 30% whole cluster pressed and fermented on the skins for 20 days. Aged in large format French oak for 18months.

Food Pairing

Enjoy with roasted organic chicken, including salty roasted potatoes smothered in drippings.
