Growing Conditions

Pinot Noir – Three Dijon clones (114, 777, 828) on three rootstocks (3309, 101-14, Paulson) were planted in 2008 on two benches and nearly every facet of our hillside vineyard in soils noted for their calcium-rich limestone clay content. The best suited rows are hand selected each vintage for red wine production.

Winemaking and Viticulture

Fermented in 1 and 4 tonne lots, including 40% whole clusters, hand-picked and sorted fruit is wild fermented to both alcoholic and malolactic dryness, then barrel aged for 18-24 months in large format (265, 300 & 500 L) French oak barrels, with a tiny percentage of new wood.

Tasting Note

Vision Pinot Noir's texture is full and satisfying with flavours that explode with notes of cherry, strawberry and spice.
